

Infinity Event Rules

TECH EVENTS

1. On Spot programming

- **Abstract:** Here is your chance to put the learning into use. Code like there is no tomorrow!
- **Skills Required:** Knowledge of C, Creativity, Programming skills.
- **Brief description of each round:**
 - First round will be a written round which will test the participant's C skills.
 - Second round will be a hands on round in which participants will showcase their programming skills and provide an efficient solution to the given problems.
- **Team Size:** Team of 2.
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs.50

2. Tech Junk yard wars

- **Abstract:** Use the Junk modules and not so junk modules create your beautiful programs!
- **Skills Required:** Knowledge of C, Creativity, Programming skills, Skill in Code Analysis.
- **Brief description of each round:**
 - First round will be a written round which will test the participant's C skills and how well they can analyze code.
 - Second round will be a hands on round in which participants will be given different functions which have misleading names and the contestants have to pick the correct functions to solve the given problem.
- **Team Size:** Team of 2.
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs.50

3. Multi-threading

- **Abstract:** The event tests the performance of a participating team when exposed to two tasks simultaneously, one technical and the other being Non-technical.
- **Skills Required:** Knowledge of C/C++ and Computer Science Concepts, Programming skills, Creativity and Time Management
- **Brief Description of each round:**
 - First round will be a written round which will test the participant's C skills and knowledge of some tech concepts.
 - Second round will have multiple levels of a programming task paired with a brain teaser task for each level. Limited number of Lifelines (hints) can be used if the team gets stuck at a level.
- **Team Size:** Team of 2
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs.50

4. Technical Quiz

- **Abstract:** The event is a basic Quiz to interest all Quizzers on technical topics
- **Skills Required:** Basic knowledge of elementary Computer Science Concepts, General knowledge on IT related topics
- **Brief Description of each round:**
 - First round will be a written prelim round which will test the participant's knowledge and quizzing skills.
 - Second final round will be oral with 3 rounds and 6 teams with a quizmaster.
- **Team Size:** Team of 3
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs.50

5. Online Treasure Hunt

- **Abstract:** The event is hosted on the infinity website and participants are expected to crack the clues
- **Skills Required:** Basic knowledge internet, on-goings of the world and How to Google!
- **Brief Description of each round:**
 - First round will hosted and each participant navigates through the webpage using the clue. More the stages crossed, higher the likely-hood to get shortlisted for next round. The quickest to clear more rounds is shortlisted
 - Second final round will be conducted at the college campus in labs. The finalists are made to crack similar clues as in first round
- **Team Size:** Individual.
- **Reg. Fees:** Free! Compete Online!

6. Mock Placement

- **Abstract:** The event brings about similar tensions of the placements, making the participant think it's the real deal!
- **Skills Required:** Basic technical knowledge, good communication skill
- **Brief Description of each round:**
 - First round will written with 60 questions to be solved in 70 minutes. The questions will include combination of technical and aptitude questions.
 - Second final round interview by skilled employees of various companies.
- **Team Size:** Individual.
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs.40

CULTURAL EVENTS

1. Fusion Dance

- **Abstract:** The event tests the performance of a participating team on how well can they dance and win the hearts of the crowd.
- **Skills Required:** Dance and team coordination
- **Brief Description of the round:**
 - Hazardous props like fire shouldn't be used.
 - Indecent costumes and obscenity can lead to disqualification
 - Team can be disqualified if the theme is not adhered to (if there is any theme)
 - The song should be made in a CD and presented half an hour before the event for testing.
 - Duration: 6+2 minutes
- **Team Size:** 4-8
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 500

2. Mad Ads (CANCELLED)

- **Abstract:** The Crazy World of Advertising- tests the participants creativity
- **Skills Required:** Innovation and creativity
- **Brief Description of the round:**
 - Props and costumes not allowed.
 - Standard MadAd rules apply.
 - Obscenity can lead to disqualification
 - Duration: 6+2 minutes.
- **Team Size:** 5-7
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 250

3. Infinity Roadies

- **Abstract:** The Tests participants daring quality and their 'whacky quotient'
- **Skills Required:** Over confidence, over expressions!!
- **Brief Description of each round:**
 - First round is written of half hour duration.
 - Second round has 15 shortlisted roadies facing tough interviews and tasks
- **Team Size:** Individual
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 50

LITERARY EVENTS

1. Potpourri

- An event with a mind boggling preliminary round consisting of a bunch of fun puzzles, rebuses and anagrams followed by a series of rounds which include Pictionary/dumb charades!
- **Team size:** Team of 3
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 50

2. SpEnt: Sports and Entertainment Quiz

- **Abstract:** The finest minds clash to determine the creme de la creme of mindsport. This event is sure to separate the best from the rest.
- **Brief Description of each round:**
 - Cross-college teams allowed.
 - Preliminary written round common to all participants
 - The top 6 teams make it to the final. The finals will comprise multiple oral and written rounds, with the top 2 teams walking away with prizes.
- **Team size:** Team of 3
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 50

3. Creative Writing

- An event to unleash the participants' creative spirit. To write one's way to glory after choosing from set topics. It may be poetry or prose.
- **Team size:** Individual
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 30

INFORMALS

1. Dead Man's Chest: The Treasure Hunt

- **Abstract:** The participants navigate through the college campus to find the treasure by decoding the clues!
- **Brief Description of the round:**
 - An alphanumeric code will be pasted at strategic locations.
 - The next clues will be given only after the current clue is solved and correct alphanumeric code is told by the team to the organizers.
 - The college route map will be provided.
 - Teams may face eliminations at each round if it is the last team to solve the clue.
 - No use of vehicles to find the clues.
- **Team Size:** Team of 4

- **Team Size:** Individual

- The event consists of four rounds, in each round the participants are made to eat some different items in each round.
- Basis of evaluation
 - Quantity of items he ate.
 - Speed at which he eats them.
- The whole process is monitored by the volunteers.
- **Team Size:** Individual
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 30

- **Brief Description of the round:**
 - The participants are to get own equipment.
 - They have to shoot the movie in the campus of RVCE and on a given theme on that day
 - A time of 24 hrs is given from the announcement of the theme.

➤ **Brief Description of the round:**

- Each participant is made to play on the computer.

➤ **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 20

8. Archery

➤ **Abstract:** The Ekalavya of Infinity can be born here at RVCE with this event! Hit the Bull's Eye!

➤ **Brief Description of the round:**

- It's a non-competitive event, so everyone can be a winner.

- Each person is given three arrows.

GAMING

- Semi finals

- Finals

 - It will be plant the bomb level. Each team will play as terrorist and counter terrorist and vice versa for 5 matches n the greater total wins out of 10 by each teams win.
- **Team size:** Team of 4

Dota

- Each player plays only for one team.
- Mode for initial rounds – ap (30 mins), quarters onwards – sd.

- Map for all rounds: 6.71b
- Objective: To score the highest, if possible to capture the world tree/frozen throne
- Preliminary Round
 - time limit:30mins
 - Winner will be decided on overall score.
 - if a team manages to capture the world tree/frozen throne that team wins irrespective of their score.
- Quarter finals
 - 8 teams
 - time limit:45mins
 - Winner will be decided on overall score.
 - if a team manages to capture the world tree/frozen throne that team wins irrespective of their score.
- Semi finals
 - 4 teams
 - Time limit:1hour
 - Winner will be decided on overall score.
 - if a team manages to capture the world tree/frozen throne that team wins irrespective of their score.
- Finals
 - there will be 2 teams.

SPORTS

1. Mini Cricket

- 7 players on each side.
- It's a knock out tournament.
- 6 overs match- per over 5 balls-> total 30 balls.
- 2 bowlers- 2 overs max. and remaining 2 overs to be bowled by 2 different bowlers.
- Hitting the ball directly outside the boundary is OUT.
- On an overstepping- no ball the batting team gets a FREE HIT.
- Short ball above the shoulder of the batsman will be called a NO BALL.
- If the ball lands directly on the boundary line then it's a SIX.
- Umpires decision is the final decision.
- Matches will be played with COSCO CRICKET BALL.
- On a no ball if the ball is hit directly outside the ground then only the no ball run will be awarded.
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs 200 per team

2. Mini Football

- Maximum allowed registrations - 128.
- A Team should consist of 5 players+2 substitutes.
- Each team will have 5 of its members playing on the field if in case of any penalty/retired hurt a team member can be replaced by a substitute.
- All rules of a normal football game apply with the exception being reduced field and goal size.
- Each match is monitored by 2 umpires who take all decisions regarding the game and his decision is final.
- Basis of evaluation
 - A team scoring more goals is declared the match winner.
 - The winning team then proceeds to next round.
- A maximum 6 rounds is required to decide the top 2 teams of the teams that are registered.
- **Reg. Fees:** Rs. 150 per team

3. Table Tennis

- Each team comprises of 2 players.
- All matches are knockout-based; winners qualify for the next round. Losers are out of the tournament.
- Each match is best of 3 i.e. two singles, 1 doubles.
- The team with 2 wins out of the 3 games in a match is declared the winner.
- The number of games in singles and doubles to be decided depending on the number of entries.
- **Reg fee.** 50/- per team.
